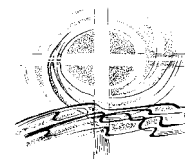

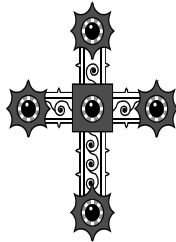

November List and 'Tree of Light'

November is month when we traditionally remember the 'Holy Souls'. There are envelopes at the Church Doors for you to place the names of those you wish to remember in, and then these can be placed in the box marked 'November List' just by the Baptism Font at Our Lady's and in the box on the Sanctuary at St. Bernard's. Please do not put any money in these envelopes. A Mass will be offered each week for all those named under the name of 'Holy Souls'. Also the 'Tree of Light' will be set up at Our Lady's for you to write the name of anyone you wish to be remembered on a label and then tie on to the 'Tree of Light'. A tin will be left for the suggested offering of £1-00 which will go to help the Charity Project that this 'Tree' will support. This year it is to raise funds for the Nutrition Project in South Africa.

School & Parish: Once again, in the coming weeks at Our Lady's there will be several events involving the Catholic High School. This Tuesday, 17th, Wednesday 18th & Thursday 19th November the Catholic High School will be using the Parish Centre during the day for Year 9 Group Retreats; the same will be true the following week. This does mean that there will be **no Tuesday Luncheon Clubs** this coming Tuesday (17th) and following Tuesday, (24th). We apologise for any inconvenience caused and thank the Luncheon Club and the other Groups involved for their support in stepping aside for these occasions. With our Schools we are one Catholic Family in this area and it is important that build up the links between us, it is for these reasons that the EPCHS Retreats are taking place at Our Lady's.

CAFOD Harvest Collection: We haven't forgotten to let you know the final total for this Collection; it hasn't yet been sent off so we'll let you know what was raised as soon as we have got all the information together.

Children's Liturgy at Our Lady's: Thanks to the initiative of several volunteers have re-started the Children's Liturgy at Our Lady's at the 11.00am Mass on Sunday. As we said before; 'Children's Liturgy' is not a 'crèche' or just a way of keeping noisy children out of Mass for a while, but a real means of helping children to feel more aware of how they can take part more fully in Mass. The children are led in prayer, then listen to the same Gospel as is read in Church, but in a children's form, prepare some symbol of their participation to bring back in the Offertory of the Mass. If any over 18 adults would still like to help please see Father Niall or Deacon Paul. New helpers will need to complete the necessary CRB Form and adhere to the Diocesan Guidelines for working with Children and Vulnerable Adults.

Flowers at Our Lady's: We are very fortunate at Our Lady's with the beautiful Flower Displays round the Church, but this does involve a lot of work. We are asking if anyone can help with this. If you feel you could help please contact Father Niall or Deacon Paul.

Our Lady's Parish Centre & Car Park: After the repairs to the Parish Centre access ramp a handrail has been placed by the door – please be careful not to drive into it! Please also, may we kindly remind people not to park in the marked disabled bays if you do not have the appropriate sticker. It is illegal, even in a private car park, to park in disabled spaces without the official sticker displayed.
