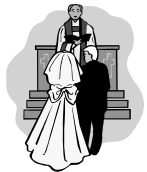
BAPTISM

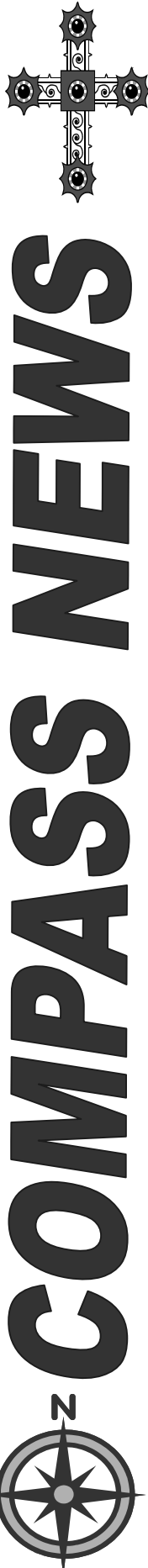
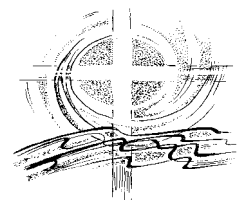
