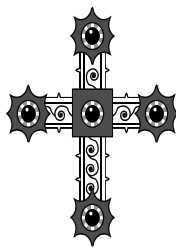
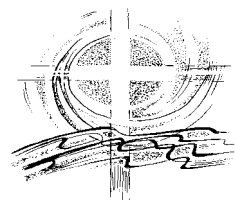

Ash Wednesday

is the first day of Lent a period of preparation through prayer, penitence, almsgiving and self-denial for the annual commemoration during Holy Week of the Death and Resurrection of Jesus, and occurs forty-six days (forty days not counting Sundays) before Easter. Ash Wednesday gets its name from the practice of placing ashes on the foreheads of the faithful as a sign of repentance. The ashes used are gathered after the Palm Crosses from the previous year's Palm Sunday are burned. The forty days represent the time that, Jesus spent in the wilderness before the beginning of his public ministry, where he endured temptation by Satan.

Ashes will be imposed during the Masses listed for this coming Wednesday.

Ash Wednesday is a day of fasting and abstinence.
