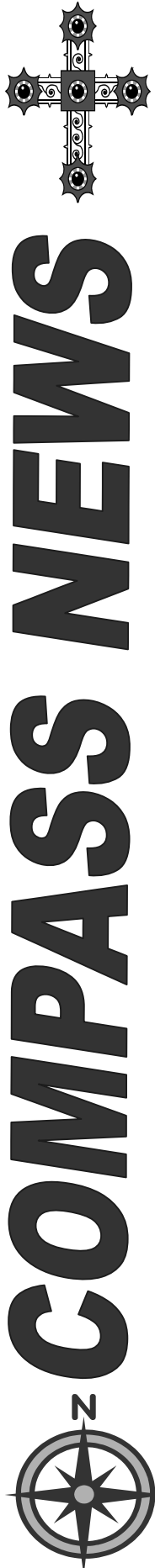
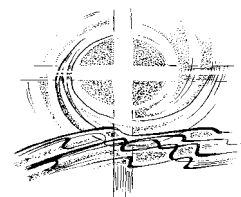

CAFOD 'Give it Up' Lent 2010

To quote CAFOD's words: "This year is the 50th anniversary of Lent Fast Day and we're asking you to give it up! Most of us usually give up something for Lent like biscuits, wine, a big dinner on a Friday. This year why not create some amazing changes for people who live in the developing world by giving the money saved to CAFOD? The money you save by missing out on your favourite biscuits each day, for example, could go towards a bicycle to help a health volunteer take food to orphaned children." Thanks to the speakers across our LPA last weekend who explained this campaign to us. We will not have a 'Fast Day Collection' as such, but this will be 'spread' across Lent. Boxes and Envelopes are still available, and as there is an opportunity to 'Gift Aid' these gifts. We have seen with the Haiti and Retired Priest's Collections the difference Gift Aid can make, so do please help in this way if you are a UK Tax Payer.

Xavierian Missionary Appeal: Each year the Diocese allows one Missionary Society to carry out the Mission Appeal. This year we are welcoming the Xavierian Missionaries, who take their inspiration from life and work of St Francis Xavier. This weekend (27th/28th February) we welcome two Xavierian Fathers to appeal at St Saviour's and St Mary's, and next weekend (6th/7th March) we welcome one Xavierian Father to appeal at Our Lady's and St Bernard's. Please keep them in your prayers. There will be a retiring collection at all Masses. We are sorry that we have had several Collections recently, but do ask you as much as you are able to support this appeal.

Welcome to Bishop Mark Davies: Last Monday, Bishop Brian, with other Bishops of England and Wales, Ordained Bishop Mark Davies as Coadjutor Bishop for our Diocese of Shrewsbury at St Anthony's Church in Wythenshawe. Clergy and Representatives from the Parishes of our LPA were present. Please keep Bishop Mark, Bishop Brian and our Diocesan Family in your prayers at this important time for us all. As a Coadjutor Bishop, Bishop Mark will eventually take over as our Diocesan Bishop when Bishop Brian retires.

Fairtrade Fortnight this started on Monday 22nd February, running until 7th March and will be the 15th annual fortnightly promotion of Fairtrade. There are now more than 4,500 products carrying the Fairtrade label and many towns, businesses, schools and parishes have become Fairtrade organisations. In fact the UK is the leading country for sales of

Fairtrade products. This is giving an enormous benefit to millions of poor farmers and their families around the world who produce the coffee, tea, bananas, cotton and other commodities that we use on a daily basis. Not only do they get a better and fairer price for their goods but they also receive a Fairtrade Premium that is put into community projects such as schools and health clinics. The theme of this year's Fairtrade Fortnight is "The Big Swap" and we are all being encouraged to swap some of our regular shopping items for Fairtrade products, to try out products we have not previously bought. We are also being asked to get local store managers to make more Fairtrade products available. We can all help to make the world a fairer place through our support of Fairtrade. AAA
