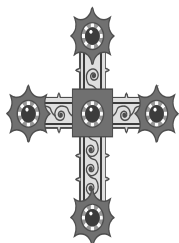
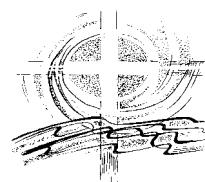

## Visit of Pope Benedict XVI next September - Special Collection:

As you will be aware, his Holiness Pope Benedict XVI is coming to Britain next September. As we prepare, the Bishops' Conference of England & Wales has asked the support of each Diocese to raise funds for the visit. Therefore there will be a Retiring Collection at all Saturday Vigil & Sundays Masses at St Saviour's, St Mary's, Our Lady's & St Bernard's this Weekend, 22<sup>nd</sup>/23<sup>rd</sup> May. This will be the only fund raising event in our Diocese for this event, so we are asked to be as generous as we are able. There are Prayer Cards, Gift Aid Envelopes and information available. The 'Communications Sunday' Collection due to take place this weekend has now been transferred to later in June.

**May Holy Hours:** This coming Friday, 28<sup>th</sup> May will be the last of our May Holy Hours; this will take place at Our Lady's from 4.00pm to 5.00pm for our whole LPA. This will be in the form of Silent Prayer with no meditations, music etc. It is simply an opportunity for people to come together and pray about the many concerns and issues of our own lives, and the wider world, in quiet prayer before the Blessed Sacrament.
