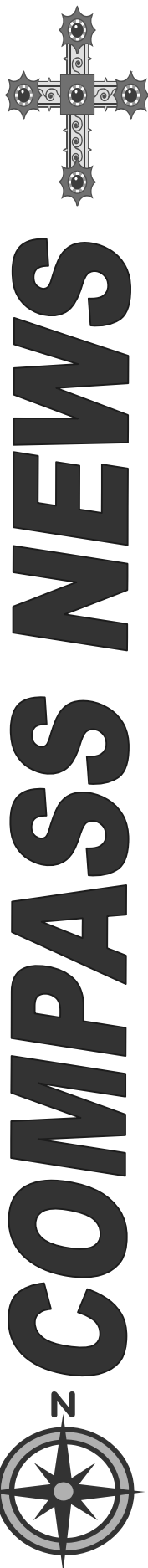
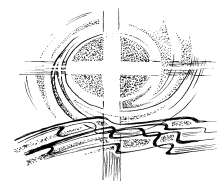

## Cafod 'Act on Poverty' Card Signing

Last year almost 60,000 cards were delivered to Downing Street calling on the Prime Minister to support the Climate Justice campaign with special concern for the poorer people in the world. As we have a new Prime Minister who will soon be making difficult decisions about spending priorities, now is a good time to ask the government to ensure that tackling global poverty continues to be high on their spending list. Cafod is asking us to urge the government to **act on poverty** by:-

**Pressing for a fair deal on climate change at the UN**

**Honouring the commitment to spend 0.7% of national income on aid by 2013**

**Ensuring businesses are accountable to people in the poor countries who are affected by their operations.**

Please take a few minutes to sign one of the "Act on Poverty" cards at the back of church next weekend. (19th-20th June) These will then be sent to Cafod to be forwarded to 10 Downing Street.
