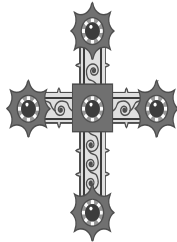
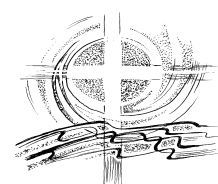

mostly be covered by Bishop Brian himself and Monsignor Chris Lightbound; our thanks and appreciation go to them both for their support.
