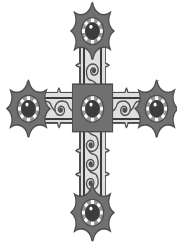
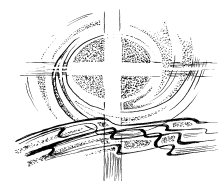

**Visit of Pope Benedict XVI:** Last weekend we spoke to everyone about the forthcoming visit of His Holiness Pope Benedict XVI to Great Britain this coming September. In England & Wales one of the main events we are being invited to is the Mass of Beatification for Cardinal John Henry Newman in Cofton Park, Birmingham, on Sunday, 19<sup>th</sup> September, which will start around 8.30am. There will be a coach organised for this event leaving from Ellesmere Port Catholic High School. Those planning to go are termed 'Pilgrims' and each will need to have a 'Pilgrim Pass' to able to enter the site. Each Group will need to have a named 'Pilgrim Leader', the Pilgrim Leader for our Local Pastoral Area (LPA) is Miss Gemma Fleming from St Mary of the Angels Parish. Gemma, working with our LPA Office, will act as the Co-ordinator for this LPA, no. 10, consisting of St Saviour's, St Mary's & Our Lady & St Bernard's with our Diocesan Co-ordinator, Deacon John Penny. We now have for the LPA 39 Pilgrim Places available. These places are being allocated through our LPA 10 Administration Office; therefore if you would like to go to the Mass in Cofton Park please contact our LPA Office on (0151) 347 9342 or e-mail: [parishesoff@rcchep.co.uk](mailto:parishesoff@rcchep.co.uk) on Monday.

Please when calling give your name, contact details and the Parish to which you belong. Each person going must be named and have contact details and should be resident in this LPA. We cannot guarantee you a place and we may have to use a 'first come, first served' process and possibly a reserve list. Times have changed since the visit of Pope John Paul II in the 80's and security will be a big concern, so places cannot be 'saved' for friends or relatives without clear contact details.

The term 'Pilgrim' for this occasion is an apt one, for in many senses it will be a real pilgrimage; a journey through the night, a long wait, a journey back probably returning mid evening on the Sunday. It is, however, a great opportunity to celebrate as the Catholic Family of this country with our Chief Shepherd; although not a great number will be able to attend, it should serve as an encouragement to us all in living our faith, and it will be good to know that people from our LPA will be representing us. If you are allocated a 'Pilgrim Place' you will receive a 'Pilgrim Pack' supplying you with all the necessary details.

There is also a Prayer Vigil with Pope Benedict XVI in Hyde Park, London, on the Evening of Saturday, 18<sup>th</sup> September. There is no organised transport to this event, so if you would like to go, please contact the Office and we'll put you in touch with a

Group who may be going. Those going to the Young Peoples Celebration with the Pope are being looked after by the Diocesan Youth Service.

The 60th Annual Diocesan Pilgrimage to Lourdes leaves at the end of the month. There is need for a few more trained nurses to accompany our sick pilgrims. If you have any intentions you would like taken to Lourdes and placed in the grotto during this year Diocesan Pilgrimage please leave in the box / basket in each parish. These will be collected and taken to Lourdes on your behalf. Please **DO NOT** put any money with these intentions.

#### **Intentions of the Pilgrimage**

For Faith – that we may confidently proclaim the Gospel through the witness of our lives.

For the Holy Father – that his forthcoming visit to England and Scotland may be a source of encouragement to the people of our countries.

For the sick members of our parish communities – that through our prayer they may find comfort and strength to endure.

**Day for Life Collection:** 'Day for Life' is the Day the Catholic Church in Ireland, Scotland, England, and Wales dedicates to celebrating the dignity of human life from conception to natural death. This year its theme is the meaning of Christian death and care for those who are dying. There are many 'Life' organisations that call for our help, and its not always clear which we

should support. That is why as a Local Pastoral Area Team we decided to focus on the Church's 'Day for Life' and sponsor it's collection for Anscombe Bioethics Centre (formally the Linacre Centre for Healthcare Ethics) and other life-related activities supported by the Church. We will hold a retiring Collection across the Four Churches of our LPA on the weekend of 24<sup>th</sup>/25<sup>th</sup> July. Leaflets and Gift Aid Envelopes should be available this weekend. We realise that in some of our Churches the 'Communications Sunday' and 'Apostleship of the Sea' Collections were overlooked. Donations will be sent to offset these Collections.

**Bishop Brian & Bishop Mark:** Bishop Brian has now announced that he will retire as Bishop of Shrewsbury and hand over to Bishop Mark on the 1<sup>st</sup> October 2010. Our gratitude and appreciation go to Bishop Brian who has given so much to our Diocesan family, and especially now as he is personally covering Masses at St Mary of the Angels whilst Father Peter is on sick leave. To say 'Thank you Bishop Brian' seems such a small recognition for so much given, but it is sincerely meant from us all. We will obviously say more about this closer to the time, but for now please keep Bishop Brian, Bishop Mark and our whole Diocesan Family in your prayers as we enter into this time of transition.

**Engage 2010:** During next week, 20<sup>th</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> July, a series of Community Projects in Ellesmere Port supported by 'Link Up' and 'Churches Together' will be taking place. We would hope to take part more as Churches next year in these events, for now please keep these events in your prayers, leaflets should be available in our Churches, if anyone would like to take part in any of the events listed. Our LPA takes a very active part in Churches Together and we are gradually seeking ways to work more closely together in living the Gospel of Christ in this area. Hopefully, we'll say more about this in the coming months.
