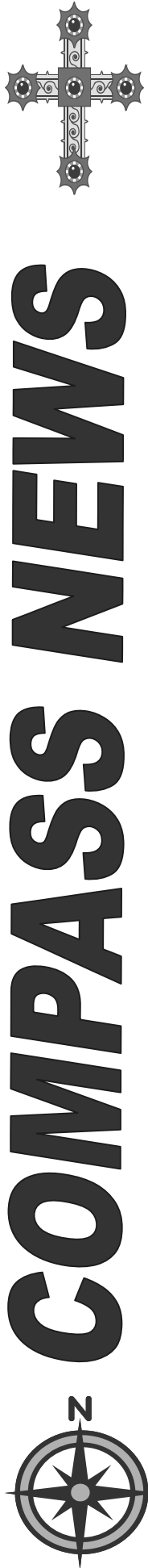
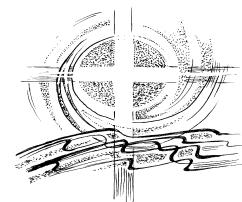

Diocesan 2012 Lourdes Pilgrimage

Tuesday 24th July to Wednesday 1st
August 2012 overland and Wednesday
25th July to Tuesday 31st July 2012 by
air. Due to the continuing fluctuation
of the euro against the pound, we shall
delay publishing our prices until the
end of February. Despite a slight rise in
hotel costs and increased costs of the
train and coaches, prices for the
overland section will be broadly the
same as last year. There may be an
increase for the air section as only two
dioceses will be using the plane in
sequence this year instead of three as
last year. In the meantime, anyone
wishing to reserve a seat on the plane
may send their £100 deposit to the
Pilgrimage Office. A brochure and
booking form will be sent as soon as
they become available. If you decide
not to proceed after our prices are
finalised your deposit will be fully
